ZAC SUMMER PROGRAMS 2023

Small group lessons 30 Minute Lessons \$100 per session

We recommend enough sessions of at least 4 total hours of swim lessons, or 8 lessons. No more than 4 children per instructor. Registration Levels for Swim Lessons-So that we may properly plan for pool space and accommodate distancing, please be sure to register for your child's appropriate swim level.

Red 1 -Your child is working on water adaptation, water safety, blowing bubbles, bobs, floats.

Red 2 -Your child can float unassisted on front and back holding for 5-10 seconds.

Yellow -Your child can safely swim 15 yards on top of the water, unassisted in 12ft. deep dive well.

Green -Your child can swim 25 yards in the lap pool unassisted.
